

Internal audit service of AMA

- coordinates all "external" audits (EC, ECA, ACA, Ministry of Agriculture)
- covers preparation, execution and follow-up
- very good overview and insight into audit results
- big administrative burden (on average 8 audits p.a.)

Coordination of CAP audit activities Audit themes

Audit themes selected by EC and ECA in Austria:

EC: topics are wide-spread, with some focus on clearance of accounts

ECA: DAS audits are dominant, topic depends on selected transactions

→ Duplicities & overlapping frequently exist (e.g. compensation payments for disadvantaged areas, agro-environmental measures), main focus on legality & regularity aspects

Coordination between ACA and ECA

- Article 287 (3) Lisbon Treaty as basis
- ACA as contact point
- in the planning of audit activities
 - annual audit programme
 - 4-month-forecast

Coordination of CAP audit activities ACA and ECA (2)

Coordination between ACA and ECA

- during the execution of audits in Austria
 - announcement letter
 - opening & closing meeting
 - preliminary findings
 - comments by auditees and/or ACA
 - final report
- role of ACA as auditor (own report) or observer
